Initiatives and Partnerships: The committee discussed partnering with various organizations, such as the Black Student Union and the SGA Student Life, to promote cultural experiences and events on campus.

Building Repairs: A suggestion to repair several buildings' bathrooms, such as door handles.

Food Services: The group discusses concerns about food services on campus, including staffing issues with Jimmy John's and the potential for introducing 24-hour food options. We discussed conducting surveys to gauge student interest in different dining options.

improvement.

Impeachment Bill today

Proposed Amendment for Constitution: To be voted on in New Business

Article VI: Legislative Assembly Section 4: Term and Succession

1. Representatives must be a candidate for a major in the college from which they are elected and carry at least six (6) semester hours.
2. Freshman representatives must fulfill all the requirements of a representative except for the qualification based on a student's major and college. Only first-year students may serve as a freshman representatives.

New Wording:

First year students may only serve as a freshman. If there proves to be any issues involving positions not being filled in other colleges, a freshman representative may be appointed to serve as a college, transfer, international, or veteran representative if they are the only eligible student to fill that representative position.

Below is the Amendment Process for Reference:

Article XII Section 1: Process

An amendment to this Constitution may be proposed to the student body by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Legislative Assembly or by ten percent (10%) of the student body of Youngstown State University upon petition to the President.

The student body shall vote on the proposed amendment at a special election or at the next regularly scheduled election.

If a simple majority of those students voting approve the amendment, it shall become a part of the Constitution.
